

kind of shorthand for joining together for some sort of liturgy. While these things may indeed be encompassed within worship, the activity may lack the substance. Worship's original meaning is to "pay someone what is their due." In relation to God. it is the "response of the creature to the Eternal." Christian worship is an intentional giving to God: acknowledgement of Who He is and what He's done, His holiness, to praise Him, to make an offering, to align our hearts with His, to bow down, to choose to love Him, to offer devotion, and so on. As we gather

together this lent, take the time to remember that worship isn't merely to be present at an event, but is a choice. It isn't simply to sing along with the hymn or song, but to use the words as an expression of our hearts and lives; to engage with the words and actions of the liturgy, times of singing, moments of quiet as a means of devotion and homage to the Lord!

May God bless you with a holy Lent!
